### 2017 T2T Campaign wraps up Dec. 31!

SPEF is again raising funds to increase technology throughout Stillwater Public Schools! Our 2017 Tech 2 Teach fundraising efforts kicked off at our fall fundraiser on Sept. 19 and will go towards the purchase of iPads for early education grades at all six elementary schools in our district. Donations are tax-deductible and any contribution to SPEF earmarked for T2T will go directly to the purchase of technology to benefit SPS students & teachers.

Since the Tech 2 Teach campaign first launched in 2013, it has funded more than \$200,000 in classroom technology that otherwise, our district would have gone without. SPEF is contributing \$15,000 to this year's campaign and our goal is raise another \$15,000 from our generous donors, so we'll have \$30K or perhaps even more to purchase iPads! 
