Grant Title: Say Something School Site: Skyline Elementary Grant Writer: Annie Ortiz

Amount: \$1,150

Provides for materials to use animation, based on the OSU Art Museum exhibit Little Nemo's Progress, to enhance engagement in social studies and social justice issues. Students will use the book *Say Something* as a basis for creating animated depictions of historical events and share their animations with peers. Materials include a variety of art supplies, tripods, lighting and iPad stands to complete the work.

Grant Title: Printmaking in the Art Room School Site: Highland Park Elementary

Amount: \$1,415

Provides for materials to teach and implement a school-wide monotype printmaking project, including using a printing press and printing plates.

Grant Title: Cultural Connections with Clay

Amount: \$700

Provides materials to incorporate the study of history and culture into the visual arts through an Arts Around the World project and a Spring Art Show through the design and creation of a sculpture that represents a country students have researched. Materials include clay and associated materials, and tools to help students through sculpting their learning of the places they researched.
